Located near the center of Iowa County on US Hwy 18/151. It has easy access to urbanized areas, including Madison, WI and Dubuque, IA. Untouched by the glaciers, the community lies in the unglaciated "driftless" area where rolling hills and rugged stone bluffs stand proud giving shape to a landscape of wooded hills, ravines and the cultivated mosaic of farm fields.

History of Area

Ridgeway is known for legendary ghost stories. From the 1840's to as late as the 1990's, there have been many reportings of the "Ridgeway Ghost". This Phantom has even reportedly killed someone, which is rare for ghost stories. The Wisconsin Historical Society points to an article in the New York Times, dated December 7, 1902. The stories number in the hundreds and include haunted houses and even werewolf sightings.
